**Señor Pachelbel Chart - C**

Play the audio and improvise single melodic lines over it (don't play chords when you're using the audio)

In the body of the email:

If you don't tell me this whole story I will be mystified about what you want and not know how to send it to you - trust me - I have the memory of a sieve.

The audio is a latin-influence version of Pachelbel's Canon in D (only I've transposed it to C). It's basically Pachelbel's Canon but with a soft Latin beat to make it a little more fun and rhythmic. In the melody on these two pages:

- Notice how the melody builds, and how chord tones are always used on beat 1 & 3.
- Notice where he uses non-chord passing tones.
- Notice how he uses sequences or melodic fragments and intersperses them with scales.

# Left Hand Pattern - Señor Pachelbel

If you're playing this solo, try this 1-5-10-5 Latin-rhythm LH pattern.

- Switch octaves as needed.
- If the 3rd note (the 10) is in the way of the RH, shift it down so you're playing 1-5-8-5 instead
- As always, if you can't play the whole pattern, just play beat 1
