

Califypso

This is like a musical game.

1. Everyone plays "Harp 1" melody together
2. Then split into "Harp 1" and "Harp 2" for the repeat
3. Then you play the "Blowing Section"
4. Rinse & Repeat (with a couple fun twists I'll add in the concert)

Melody

"Blowing Section" Notes
